

General Swimming Pool Rules:

- Directions given by lifeguards are to be followed; otherwise you may be asked to leave with without refund of admission fee.
- NO RUNNING, DUNKING, FIGHTING or HORSE PLAY is allowed.
- NO DIVING in marked areas.
- NO HANGING on the diving board and ropes is allowed.
- NO CATCHING, pushing or assisting those using the diving boards.
- NO RUNNING on the diving boards.
- Unauthorized use of the pool is prohibited.
- Profanity, improper behavior or vulgar language **WILL NOT** be tolerated.
- No Diapers are allowed in the pool. Kids (not potty trained) must wear "Little Swimmers" or disposable swim pants.
- Children under the age of 8 must be supervised at all times by someone at least 12 years of age.
- Inexperienced swimmers are not allowed in the deep end. Lifeguards will observe and their decision stands.
- NO FOOD or DRINK with the exception of bottled water is allowed in the pool area.
- NO PETS are allowed in the pool area or building.
- Only lifeguards are allowed in or on the guard chairs.
- No visiting with lifeguards while they are duty.
- Swimming pool personnel ARE NOT responsible for lost or stolen items.
- This is a tobacco, drug and alcohol free facility. Anyone under the influence will not be permitted.
- ABSOLUTELY NO inflatable devices are allowed in the pool.

The pool rules and regulations are made and enforced for your safety. Please be considerate of other swimmers and the responsibilities of the pool staff.

THE POOL PERSONNEL RESERVES THE RIGHT TO ENFORCE RULES NOT SPECIFICALLY WRITTEN TO ENSURE THE SAFETY OF THE POOL USERS.

Admission Fees (2021):

Daily Admission: \$3.00 - 18 years or younger

\$5.00 - Adult

Family Season Pass: \$75.00 - Immediate family members living in the same household. This includes 2 adults and children living in the same household that are under the age of 18 years old. Other restrictions may apply.

Individual Season Pass: \$40.00

***No refunds will be issued for season passes or daily admission for any reason.**

Free season passes are available for qualified individual/families. "Family" applies to immediate family members living in the same household, including youth age 18 and under. Only two people over the age of 18 in the household can be on the swim pass. To qualify, free pass applicants must provide:

- Photo ID
- Plus **one** of the following: Dakota EBT Card (Food Stamp Card), South Dakota Medical Card, or School District Notification Letter of Approval for free or reduced-priced meals.

PRIVATE POOL PARTY

\$180 for 2 hours (2 lifeguards will be required) Contact City Hall or speak to the pool manager for times and to book a party. For parties over 50 swimmers additional guards will be required. Each additional guard will be an extra \$50.

NO alcohol is ever allowed at the pool. All rules still apply during private parties.

REASONS FOR CLOSING THE POOL:

- The air temperature is 70 degrees or less.
- The quality of the water or the facility presents a health or safety hazard.
- There is lightning visible or a severe storm warning has been issued for the area.
- Lack of participation - four (4) or fewer swimmers after 7:00pm.
